IDAPA 38.06.01 - Rules of the Department of Administration Governing Billing Procedures of the Office of the Chief Information Officer (New Chapter) - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 38-0601-1401)

The Department of Administration submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 38.06.01 - Rules of the Department of Administration Governing Billing Procedures of the Office of the Chief Information Officer (New Chapter). The Department states that this new chapter documents calculation methods for allocating technology overhead costs and for technology service charges billed from the Department's Office of the Chief Information Officer. Specifically, this rulemaking addresses the areas of Idaho agency IT support, network services, telephone services, cybersecurity services, the Idaho Technology Authority, internet service and consolidated services.

The Department states that negotiated rulemaking was conducted and that Notice of Intent to Promulgate Rules - Negotiated Rulemaking was published in the June edition of the Idaho Administrative Bulletin. There is no fiscal impact associated with this rulemaking.

The proposed rule appears to be within the statutory authority granted to the Department in Sections 67-5701 and 67-5747, Idaho Code.
