**SUBJECT:** Bureau of Occupational Licenses - State Board of Morticians

IDAPA 24.08.01 - Rules of the State Board of Morticians - Temporary and Proposed Rule (Docket No. 24-0801-1601)

The State Board of Morticians through the Bureau of Occupational Licenses submits notice of temporary and proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 24-0801-1601. The temporary and proposed rule changes the length of time that a person may be licensed as a resident trainee from two to three years. This change conforms to the same change made to the statutes by the Legislature by 2016 House Bill 367.

According to the Bureau, the Governor has found that temporary adoption of the rule is appropriate to conform the rule to state law. Negotiated rulemaking was not conducted. There is no anticipated impact to the state general fund. The Bureau states that the rule is authorized pursuant to Sections 54-1106 and 54-1107, Idaho Code.
