SUBJECT: Bureau of Occupational Licenses - Idaho Driving Businesses Licensure Board

IDAPA 24.25.01 - Rules of the Idaho Driving Businesses Licensure Board - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 24-2501-1601)

The Idaho Driving Businesses Licensure Board submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 24.25.01 - Rules of the Idaho Driving Businesses Licensure Board. The proposed rule revises the requirements for the list of licensed instructors that a driving business must keep and submit, provides that a business may utilize a third party for on-line instruction with certain conditions, provides a timeframe for sending student performance information to the DMV and revises the requirements for the medical examination required of a driving instructor.

The Board states that negotiated rulemaking was not conducted because the changes were discussed in noticed, open meetings of the Board. There is no fiscal impact associated with this rulemaking.

The proposed rule appears to be within the statutory authority granted to the Board in Section 54-5403, Idaho Code.
