## IDAPA 13.01.07 Taking of Upland Game Animals

#### 300. **WOUNDING - RETRIEVING.**

No person shall wound or kill any upland game animal without making a reasonable effort to retrieve it and reduce it to possession. Every upland game animal wounded by hunting and reduced to possession shall immediately be killed and become a part of the daily bag limit. (7 - 1 - 93)

#### UPLAND GAME ANIMALS SEASONS, BAG AND POSSESSION LIMITS. 400. The following seasons, bag and possession limits shall apply STATEWIDE: (7-1-93)01. Cottontail Rabbits and Pygmy Rabbits. (7 - 1 - 93)a. Seasons: September 1 through February 28, annually. (10-26-94)b. Daily bag limit is eight (8) in the aggregate. (7 - 1 - 93)Possession limit after the first day of the season is sixteen (16) in the aggregate. (7 - 1 - 93)c. 02. Snowshoe Hares. (7-1-93)Seasons: September 1 through March 31, annually. (10-26-94)a. Daily bag limit is eight (8). (7 - 1 - 93)b. Possession limit after the first day of the season is sixteen (16). (7 - 1 - 93)c.
