NOTICE OF INTENT TO PROMULGATE RULES - NEGOTIATED RULEMAKING

AUTHORITY: In compliance with Section 67-5220, Idaho Code, notice is hereby given that this agency intends to promulgate rules and desires public comment prior to initiating formal rulemaking procedures. This negotiated rulemaking action is authorized pursuant to Section 54-912, Idaho Code.

METHOD OF PARTICIPATION: Interested persons wishing to participate in the negotiated rulemaking must respond to this notice by contacting the undersigned either in writing, by email, or by calling the phone number listed below. To participate, responses must be received by July 24, 2013.

Should a reasonable number of persons respond to this notice, negotiated meetings will be scheduled and all scheduled meetings shall be posted and made accessible on the Board's website at <http://isbd.idaho.gov/>.

Upon conclusion of the negotiated rulemaking, any unresolved issues, all key issues considered, and conclusions reached during the negotiated rulemaking will be addressed in a written summary and made available on the agency website.

Failure of interested persons to respond to this notice of intent or the lack of a sufficient number of responses to this notice of intent may result in the discontinuation of further informal proceedings. In either event the agency shall have sole discretion in determining the feasibility of scheduling and conducting informal negotiated rulemaking and may proceed directly to formal rulemaking if proceeding with negotiated rulemaking is deemed infeasible.

Anyone may submit written comments regarding this negotiated rulemaking. All written comments must be directed to the undersigned by mail or email and must be delivered on or before July 24, 2013.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The following is a statement in nontechnical language of the substance and purpose of the intended negotiated rulemaking and the principle issues involved:

Proposed changes include incorporation by reference of the 8th Edition of the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, Office Anesthesia Evaluation Manual, dated 2012; clarification that a dental hygienist is prohibited from taking any type of final impression; clarification of dental assistant prohibited duties and the addition of the use of prophyljet to prohibited duties; release of patient records; revision of rules concerning advertising based on enforceability; reduction of the number of continuing education hours required for renewal of an extended access dental hygiene license endorsement from twelve (12) to four (4) hours; deletion of the requirement of live clinical dental experiences in the educational requirements to obtain a moderate enteral sedation permit; and various housekeeping changes. The Board is also considering a reduction in licensing fees.
