NOTICE OF INTENT TO PROMULGATE RULES – NEGOTIATED RULEMAKING

AUTHORITY: In compliance with Sections 67-5220(1) and 67-5220(2), Idaho Code, notice is hereby given that this agency intends to promulgate rules and desires public comment prior to initiating formal rulemaking procedures. DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY AND STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The following is a statement in nontechnical language of the substance and purpose of the intended negotiated rulemaking and the principle issues involved:

The draft amendments will clarify that licensed professional engineer's or land surveyor's ethical obligations preclude the submission bids for professional services on public projects per Section 67-2320, Idaho Code. The current rule disallows the submission of bids. The amendment clarifies that licensees include both consultants and sub-consultants.
