SUBJECT: Bureau of Occupational Licenses - Idaho Board of Cosmetology

IDAPA 24.04.01 - Rules of the Idaho Board of Cosmetology (Docket No. 24-0401-1301) - **Fee Rule**

The Bureau of Occupational Licenses, on behalf of the Idaho Board of Cosmetology, submits notice of proposed fee rulemaking. The proposed fee rule reduces 16 different fees that are listed in Rule 125 and found on page 328. The Bureau states that as a result of this fee rulemaking, it is anticipated that the amount of dedicated fund fees collected annually by the Board will be reduced by approximately \$119,905. There is no negative fiscal impact to the state general fund as a result of this rulemaking.

Other proposed rule changes include the following:

- (1) Defines the term "clinical services";
- (2) Requires inspection reports be submitted to the Board for its consideration in issuing a school of cosmetology license;
- (3) Clarifies that students may not render any clinical services to patrons until the student has completed at least 5% of the required hours of instruction; and
- (4) Clarifies that all shops and schools must display a copy of sanitary rules in the work area.

The Board's proposed fee rule changes are authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 54-818, Idaho Code. The Board's other proposed rule changes are authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 54-821, Idaho Code.
