1. IDAPA 46.01.01 - Rules of the State of Idaho Board of Veterinary Medicine

The Board of Veterinary Medicine submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 46.01.01 - Rules of the State of Idaho Board of Veterinary Medicine. According to the Board, the purpose of the rulemaking is to correct a misstatement regarding the time period for completing continuing education by certified veterinary technicians, to insert language authorizing certified veterinary technicians to dispense and deliver certain previously prescribed antibiotics and medications under the indirect supervision of a veterinarian, to provide a more realistic time period for veterinarians to respond to a request for records and to modify and specify provisions relating to the training and examination of certified euthanasia technicians.

The Board notes that negotiated rulemaking was conducted and that provisions relating to euthanasia technicians were revised at the recommendation of the Certified Euthanasia Task Force. The rulemaking appears to be authorized pursuant to Section 54-2105, Idaho Code.

2. IDAPA 46.01.01 - Rules of the State of Idaho Board of Veterinary Medicine

The Board of Veterinary Medicine submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 46.01.01 - Rules of the State of Idaho Board of Veterinary Medicine. According to the Board, the purpose of the rulemaking is to authorize continuing education credits for course presenters and to clarify credit hours awarded for continuing education panel presentations. Negotiated rulemaking was not conducted due to the simple nature of the rulemaking. The rule appears to be authorized pursuant to Section 54-2105, Idaho Code.
