IDAPA 24.25.01 - Rules Pertaining To the Idaho Driving Businesses Licensure Board (Docket No. 24-2501-1401)

The Bureau of Occupational Licenses submits notice of temporary and proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 24.25.01 - Rules Pertaining To the Idaho Driving Businesses Licensure Board. This rulemaking is being done in accordance with House Bill 359 (2014) and allows the Board to waive apprenticeship requirements for driving instructor licensure for applicants who hold a current, equivalent instructor license from another state or who have held a public driver education instructor license from the Idaho State Department of Education for two yearsh. Applicants are required to provide proof to the Board

The Bureau states that negotiated rulemaking was not conducted because the rule is needed to conform with HB 359 and that a temporary rule is necessary because HB 359 contains an emergency clause. There is no fiscal impact associated with this rulemaking.

The proposed rule appears to be within the statutory authority granted to the Bureau in Section 54-5403, Idaho Code.
