IDAPA 24.17.01 - Rules Pertaining to the State Board of Acupuncture - Proposed Rule (Fee Rule) (Docket No. 24-1701-1401)

The State Board of Acupuncture submits noticed of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 24.17.01. The proposed rule decreases fees for applications, licenses, and license renewals. According to the Board, the purpose of the rule is to decrease the Board's dedicated fund and to convey a benefit to licensees and applicants.

There is no negative fiscal impact on the state general fund, but the Board estimates that the dedicated fund will be reduced by \$7,850.00. Negotiated rulemaking was not conducted. The proposed rule is consistent with the Board's authority under Sections 54-4705 and 54-4710, Idaho Code.
