SUBJECT: Bureau of Occupational Licenses - State Board of Massage Therapy

IDAPA 24.27.01 - Rules Pertaining to the Idaho State Board of Massage Therapy - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 24-2701-1401)

The Board of Massage Therapy submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 24.27.01. The proposed rule removes "light" as a continuing education content area because light is not included in the Idaho Code's defined practice area for massage therapy. The proposed rule also adds a new section clarifying the supervision required for clinical work and fieldwork.

There is no negative fiscal impact on the state general fund. The Board did not conduct negotiated rulemaking. The rule is consistent with the Board's rulemaking authority under Section 54-4007(3), Idaho Code.
