SUBJECT: Idaho Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors

IDAPA 10.01.03 - Rules for Corner Perpetuation and Filing - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 10-0103-1401)

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors submits notice of proposed rule-making at IDAPA 10.01.03 - Rules for Corner Perpetuation and Filing. The Board states that this rule will "require surveyors to perpetuate historic corner record information on the Corner Perpetuation and Filing (CP&F) forms filed or recorded in the county courthouse in lieu of listing all corner record instrument numbers on the Record of Survey map." The Board further states that there is insufficient room on the map to list all corner record instrument numbers without creating a map that is not legible to read. In addition, this rule now requires a sketch of monument and accessories found or established to perpetuate the location of a corner as well as a description.

Negotiated rulemaking was conducted and Notice of Intent to Promulgate Rules - Negotiated Rulemaking was published in the August Idaho Administrative Bulletin. A public hearing concerning this rulemaking will be held in Meridian on October 14. There is no fiscal impact associated with this rulemaking.

The proposed rule appears to be within the statutory authority granted to the Board in Section 54-1208, Idaho Code.
