#### **(1) Rules Governing Thoroughness - Temporary and Proposed Rule (Docket No. 08-0203-1508)**

The Department of Education submits Notice of Temporary and Proposed Rulemaking that specifies the total timeline from the determination that a student needs special education and related services to the date of implementation of the initial IEP shall not exceed 30 days, with no exclusions or extensions of time.

The Department's proposed rule appears to be authorized by Section 33-105, Idaho Code.

#### **(2) Rules Governing Thoroughness - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 08-0203-1509)**

The Department of Education submits Notice of Proposed Rulemaking relating to Rules Governing Thoroughness. The proposed rule updates several documents incorporated by reference relating to Idaho Content Standards adopted by the State Board of Education on August 13, 2015, defines the terms "Interdisciplinary Study" and "Project Based Learning," and adds "arts" to the "humanities" credit completion requirements for high school graduation.

The Department's proposed rule appears to be authorized by Section 33-105, Idaho Code.

#### **(3) Rules Governing Thoroughness - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 08-0203-1510)**

The Department of Education submits Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that adds physical education to a list of subject areas for which curricular materials are adopted. The Department states that physical education has been a part of a scheduled review process for over the past decade.

The Department's proposed rule appears to be authorized by Section 33-105, Idaho Code.

**(4) Rules Governing Thoroughness - Proposed Rule (Docket No. 08-0203-1511)**

The Department of Education submits Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that eliminates references to the Idaho English Language Assessment Achievement Standards document and updates the definition of "Achievement Standards" as it relates to the Idaho English Language Assessment.

The Department's proposed rule appears to be authorized by Section 33-105, Idaho Code.
