The Idaho State Police submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 11.13.01 - The Motor Carrier Rules - Temporary and Proposed Rule. This rule change incorporates by reference the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. The ISP states that this is being adopted for interstate transportation so that drivers do not have to comply with different rules in each state. The ISP further states that this incorporation by reference does not adopt any new federal regulations.

The ISP states that negotiated rulemaking was not conducted because there was no substantive change to the rule and no new federal regulations were adopted. There is no fiscal impact associated with this rulemaking.

The temporary and proposed rulemaking appears to be within the statutory authority granted to the ISP in Section 67-2901, Idaho Code.
