IDAPA 49.01.01 - Rules of Procedure of the Idaho Certified Shorthand Reporters Board - Fee Rule, Proposed Rule (Docket No. 49-0101-1501)

The Idaho Certified Shorthand Reporters Board submits notice of proposed rulemaking at IDAPA 49.01.01 - Rules of Procedure of the Idaho Certified Shorthand Reporters Board - Fee Rule, Proposed Rule. This proposed rulemaking increases the reinstatement fee for a shorthand reporter's certificate from \$25 to \$35 in accordance with Section 67-2614, Idaho Code. The Board states that it has decided to amend its rules to align with the statute of the Bureau of Occupational Licenses rather than its own individual licensing requirements.

The Board states that negotiated rulemaking was not conducted because this proposed change was discussed at open meetings to which interested parties were welcome to attend. There is no expected impact to the general fund with this rulemaking.

The proposed rule appears to be within the statutory authority granted to the Board in Sections 54-3107 and 67-2614, Idaho Code.

### STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC IMPACT:

This rule will increase the reinstatement fee from \$25 to \$35. The number of annual renewal fees collected will be capped at just one (1) rather than one (1) for each year that a license is expired. It is expected that the higher reinstatement fees will be offset by the lower reinstatement fees and the fact that multiple renewal fees will no longer be collected.
