IDAPA 11.04.00 - Notice of Omnibus Rulemaking - Temporary and Proposed Fee Rulemaking (Docket No. 11-0400-1900F) - Idaho State Police/Racing Commission

The Idaho State Racing Commission submits notice of temporary and proposed rules that reauthorize and re-publish the following previously approved chapters at:

- 11.04.02, Rules Governing Simulcasting except for Subsections 010.06 and 010.13, Sections 047, 049 through 057 that all were related to historical horse racing and are now obsolete
- 11.04.03, Rules Governing Licensing and Fees
- 11.04.05, Rules Governing Advanced Deposit Wagering
- 11.04.07, Rules Governing Racing Associations
- 11.04.11, Rules Governing Equine Veterinary Practices, Permitted Medications, Banned Substances and Drug Testing of Horses
- 11.04.15, Rules Governing Controlled Substance and Alcohol Testing of Licensees, Employees, and Applicants

In addition to the omissions noted above, there are some minor, nonsubstantive changes that were made. These rules were previously analyzed and reviewed by the Legislative Services Office upon their initial promulgation. No other changes from the existing rules have been noted.

This is a fee rule. According to the commission, this rulemaking does not impose a fee or charge, or increase a fee or charge, beyond what was previously approved and codified in the prior rules.

The rulemaking appears to be authorized pursuant to Sections 54-2506, 54-2507, 54-2508, 54-2509, 54-2512, 54-2513, and 54-2514, Idaho Code.
