SUBJECT: Office of the Governor - Idaho State Liquor Division

IDAPA 15.10.00 - Notice of Omnibus Rulemaking - Temporary and Proposed Fee Rulemaking (Docket No. 15-1000-1900F)

The Idaho State Liquor Division has submitted temporary and proposed rules that reauthorize and republish IDAPA 15.10.01, Rules of the Idaho State Liquor Division.

These rules were previously analyzed and reviewed by the Legislative Services Office upon their initial promulgation. However, changes from the previously approved rules are noted as follows:

The Division has removed a subsection and obsolete language regarding the shipment and storage of liquor that contradicted the actual authority granted to the Director and placed impractical burdens on the Division.

The Division has also removed a redundant subsection regarding rule petitions that is already contained in Idaho Code.

The rule changes appear to be within the Division's statutory authority to promulgate rules provided in Section 23-206, Idaho Code.

This is a fee rule. No new fees or charges, or changes to existing fees or charges, are noted in this docket.

No other substantive changes from the existing rules have been noted.
