- IDAPA 52.00.00 Notice of Omnibus Rulemaking Temporary and Proposed Fee Rulemaking (Docket No. 52-0000-1900F) Idaho State Lottery Commission

The Idaho State Lottery Commission submits notice of temporary and proposed rules that reauthorize and re-publish the following previously approved chapters at:

• IDAPA 52.01.02, Gaming Rules of the Idaho State Lottery Commission – A technical modification was made to Section 003 to incorporate content previously included in IDAPA 52.01.01 which was not reauthorized and re-published. According to the commission, that chapter was unnecessary and only necessary content was retained and incorporated in 52.01.02.

• IDAPA 52.01.03, Rules Governing Operations of the Idaho State Lottery Commission – All rules except Section 203. (According to the commission, this rule outlined a Lottery Television Game Show that has never been considered for use, nor is expected to ever be used.)

In addition to the changes noted above, some minor revisions were made and some material was moved from one section/subsection to another. No other changes from the existing rules have been noted.

This is a fee rule. According to the commission, this rulemaking does not impose a fee or charge, or increase a fee or charge, beyond what was previously approved and codified in the prior rules.

The rulemaking appears to be authorized pursuant to Section 67-7408, Idaho Code.
