# 07.01.06 - RULES GOVERNING THE USE OF NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE

# 000. LEGAL AUTHORITY.

The Idaho Electrical Board is authorized under Section 54-1001, Idaho Code, to adopt rules concerning the use of the National Electrical Code. (2-26-93)

#### 001. TITLE AND SCOPE.

These rules shall be cited as IDAPA 07, Title 01, Chapter 06, Rules Governing the Use of National Electrical Code, Department of Labor and Industrial Services. These rules prescribe which edition of the National Electrical Code will be administered by the Idaho Electrical Board. (2-26-93)

# 011. NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1996 EDITION.

01. Documents. Under the provisions of Section 54-1001A, Idaho Code, the National Electrical Code, 1996 Edition, is hereby adopted for the State of Idaho and shall be in full force and effect on and after the conclusion of the 1997 legislative session, except: Article 675-8(b) is to include the additional requirement that a disconnecting means always be provided at the point of service from the utility no matter where the disconnecting means for the machine is located.
