TITLE 01
CHAPTER 50**

18.01.50 - ADOPTION OF 1994 UNIFORM FIRE CODE

000. LEGAL AUTHORITY.

These rules are promulgated and adopted pursuant to the authority vested in the Director under Title 41, Chapter 2, Idaho Code. (6-30-95)

001. TITLE AND SCOPE.

01. Title. These rules shall be cited as Rules of the Idaho Department of Insurance, IDAPA 18, Title 01, Chapter 50. "Adoption of the 1994 Uniform Fire Code." (6-30-95)

02. Scope. Pursuant to the authority provided by Idaho Code Section 41-253 the Idaho Fire Marshal hereby adopts the 1994 edition of the Uniform Fire Code as published by the International Fire Code Institute in cooperation with International Conference of Building Officials, Western Fire Chiefs Association and the International Association of Fire Chiefs, with the following revisions, additions, deletions and appendixes. (6-30-95)

002. WRITTEN INTERPRETATIONS.

In accordance with Section 67-5201(16)(b)(iv), Idaho Code, this agency may have written statements which pertain to the interpretation of the rules of the chapter, or to the documentation of compliance with the rules of this chapter. These documents will be available for public inspection and copying at cost in the main office and each regional or district office of this agency. (6-30-95)

003. ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS.

All contested cases shall be governed by the provisions of IDAPA 04.11.01, Idaho Rules of Administrative Procedure of the Office of the Attorney General. (6-30-95)

011. SECTION 104.3.2. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 104.3.2. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: The fire department shall retain for not less than five (5) years a record of each investigation made showing the cause, the findings and disposition of each investigation. (6-30-95)

016. SECTION 105.8. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

The introductory language to Section 105.08. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: A permit may be obtained from the bureau of fire prevention prior to engaging in the following activities, operations, practices or functions: (6-30-95)

021. SECTION 204. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 204. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: Chief is the chief of the fire department serving the jurisdiction, the chief officer's authorized representative, or as appropriate the Idaho State Fire Marshal. (6-30-95)

026. SECTION 1003.1.1. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 1003.1.1. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: Fire extinguishing systems shall be installed in accordance with the current appropriate edition of the National Fire Protection Association standards and Section 1003. (6-30-95)

027. -- 030. (RESERVED).

031. SECTION 1003.1.2. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 1003.1.2. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: Fire extinguishing systems shall comply with the current appropriate edition of the National Fire Protection Association standards and Section 1003. (6-30-95)

032. -- 035. (RESERVED).

036. SECTION 1101.1. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 1101.1. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: General safety precautions shall be in accordance with Article 11. The Chief may be guided by Appendices II-A and II-C. (6-30-95)

041. ARTICLE 78 UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

"Fireworks and Pyrotechnic Special Effects Material" 1994 Uniform Fire Code Volume 1, be deleted with the exception of 7802.4 through 7803.9. (6-30-95)

046. SECTION 7902.1.7.2.3. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 7902.1.7.2.3. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: Underground tanks that comply with the performance standards for new or upgraded underground tanks set forth in 40 CFR 280.20 or 40 CFR 280.21 E.P.A. final rule may remain out of service indefinitely so long as they remain in compliance with the operation, maintenance and release detection requirements of the final rule. (6-30-95)

047. -- 050. (RESERVED).

051. SECTION 8003.3.1.3.5.1. UNIFORM FIRE CODE.

Section 8003.3.1.3.5.1. Uniform Fire Code, be, and the same is amended to read as follows: Upon approval of the Authority having jurisdiction, emergency response kits recommended by the Chlorine Institute may be used for chlorine gas product leaks in lieu of the treatment system requirements of this section, as long as there are adequate responders immediately available, who are trained in their use and acceptable to the authority having jurisdiction. (6-30-95)
