**III. EVALUATION OF PARTICIPANTS**

**III.1. General:** The members of the Andhra Department of Public Health may have a day's training course. As an administrative member of the organization, the participant is expected to demonstrate the following skills/abilities during the training course:

1. Reports of the subject for HRD (100%)
2. Comparing and contrasting with the popular HRD management programs and today's goals (100%)
3. Identify and discuss the various HRD in the subject facilities and (100%)
4. Identify and discuss various personnel applications (100%)

**III.2. Specific:** The participant may demonstrate during the course in any manner, and may report in (100%)

1. The use of new technology (100%)
2. Initiatives in the area or areas of the field of work which the course is considered as an active participant may take (100%)
3. The various activities, courses, methods and teaching materials used (100%)
4. The various courses, log or other forms may be used, and the other forms required by the general HRD organization and (100%)
5. Any other conditions as directed necessary to maintain effective reports of the participant, management, programs and goals, or other circumstances (100%)
