07.01.07 - RULES GOVERNING CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS DIVISION OF BUILDING SAFETY

000. LEGAL AUTHORITY.

The Idaho Electrical Board is authorized under Sections 54-1003 and 54-1006(5), Idaho Code, to adopt rules concerning the continuing education requirements for journeyman and master journeyman licensing. (2-26-93)

001. TITLE AND SCOPE.

These rules shall be cited as IDAPA 07.01.07, "Rules Governing Continuing Education Requirements," Division of Building Safety. These rules include criteria for requirements for continuing education for electrical licensees.

011. CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS.

Journeymen and Master Electricians must complete at least sixteen (16) hours of continuing education instruction in every three (3) year period between updates of the National Electrical Code. Instruction will consist of eight (8) hours of code update covering changes included in the latest edition of the National Electrical Code, and eight (8) hours of electrical industry related instruction covering subjects other than code update. The Electrical Board will establish criteria for approval of instruction and instructors, and courses and instructors will be approved by the Bureau. Proof of completion of these continuing education requirements must be submitted to the Bureau prior to or with the application for license renewal by any such licensee in order to renew a journeyman or master electrician license for the code change year.
