IDAPA 15 - OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

IDAHO COMMISSION FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED

15.02.01 - FEDERAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS

000. LEGAL AUTHORITY.

The Idaho Legislature has given to the Board of the Idaho Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired the legislative power to promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with Section 67, Chapter 54, Idaho Code.

001. TITLE AND SCOPE.

These rules shall be known as Idaho Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired Rules, IDAPA 15.02.01, "Federal Laws and Regulations," and specify the conditions under which eligibility is determined and rehabilitation services are provided to the legally blind.
