A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DIVISION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING PLUMBING SAFETY LICENSING

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 675291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the Division of Building Safety relating to Rules Governing Plumbing Safety Licensing is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.02.05, Rules Governing Plumbing Safety Licensing, Rules of the Division of Building Safety, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 07-0205-0901, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.

Statement of Purpose / Fiscal Impact:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE RS19668

This concurrent resolution would reject an entire docket of a pending rule of the Division of Building Safety relating to Rules Governing Plumbing Safety Licensing. The effect of this resolution, if adopted by both houses, would be to prevent the agency rulemaking contained in that docket from going into effect.
