A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING LICENSE PLATE PROVISIONS

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 675291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the Transportation Department relating to Rules Governing License Plate Provisions is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 39.02.60, Rules Governing License Plate Provisions, Section 204, relating to Permanent Commercial Trailer - Business Logo Plates Provisions, only, Rules of the Transportation Department, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 39-0260-0901, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect

Statement of Purpose / Fiscal Impact:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE RS19640

This concurrent resolution would reject a subsection of a pending rule of the Department of Transportation relating to the Rules Governing License Plate Provisions. The effect of this resolution, if adopted by both houses, would be to prevent the language in the subsection of the agency rule as amended from going into effect.

This concurrent resolution has no fiscal impact.
