A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING FISH

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 675291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the Department of Fish and Game relating to Rules Governing Fish is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 13.01.11, Rules Governing Fish, Section 201, Fishing Methods and Gear, Subsection 11, Use of Hands, only, relating to Rules of the Department of Fish and Game, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 13-0111-0901, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect

Statement of Purpose / Fiscal Impact:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE RS19682

This concurrent resolution would reject a subsection of a pending rule of the Department of Fish & Game relating to the Rules Governing Fish. The effect of this resolution, if adopted by both houses, would be to prevent the language in the subsection of the agency rule as amended from going into effect.
