IDAPA 02 – DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

02.01.02 – INTEREST CHARGE RULES

000. LEGAL AUTHORITY.

This chapter is adopted under the legal authority of Idaho Code Section 22-103(22). (6-30-19)T

001. TITLE AND SCOPE.

01. Title. The title of this chapter is IDAPA 02.01.02, “Interest Charge Rules.” (6-30-19)T

02. Scope. These rules govern the interest charged on past due accounts, establish the interest rate, and provide for extreme financial hardship waiver. (6-30-19)T

002. WRITTEN INTERPRETATIONS.

003. ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL.

Persons are entitled to appeal agency actions authorized under these rules pursuant to Title 67, Chapter 52, Idaho Code. (6-30-19)T

012. INTEREST CHARGE.

01. Interest Charge on Late Accounts. An interest charge may be assessed on all accounts which are thirty (30) days past due from the initial billing date or the assessment due date. In cases of extreme financial hardship experienced by the debtor, the assessment may be waived. (4-22-91)

02. Interest Rate. Twelve percent (12%) per annum. (4-22-91)
