Who does this rule apply to?

This rule applies to insurers of liability insurance for motor vehicles.

What is the purpose of this rule?

The purpose of this rule identifies requirements of Sections 49-1229, 49-1231, and 49-1608A, Idaho Code, relating to the certificate of liability insurance for motor vehicles.

What is the legal authority for the agency to promulgate this rule?

This rule implements the following statutes passed by the Idaho Legislature:

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18.02.03 - CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

000. LEGAL AUTHORITY.

Title 49, Sections 49-1229, 49-1231, and 49-1608A, Idaho Code.

001. SCOPE.

To identify the form of a certificate of liability insurance for motor vehicles per Sections 49-1229, 49-1231 and 49-1608A, Idaho Code. (4-6-23)

002. -- 010. (RESERVED)

011. CONTRACT OF INSURANCE -- CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE.

A certificate of liability insurance can be the original liability insurance contract, or a copy thereof, or a written binder, showing active motor vehicle liability insurance in at least the applicable amounts prescribed by Sections 49-117(20), 49-1212, 49-1229, and 49-1608A, Idaho Code, and also any other coverage prescribed by Title 41, Idaho Code. (4-6-23)

012. MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR A CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE IN LIEU OF THE CONTRACT OF INSURANCE.

A document constitutes a certificate of liability insurance if it has these characteristics: (4-6-23)
